## 3-2: Converting Fractions, Decimals, and Percents

A "Percent" is a ratio that compares a number to 100.
Changing percents to fractions:
To convert a percent into a fraction just write the number over 100, then simplify your fraction.

Changing fractions to decimals:
To convert a fraction into a decimal, simply divide the numerator by the denominator.
(You may use a calculator.)
Changing percents to decimals:
Long way - Convert percent to fraction, then fraction to decimal.
Short way - Dividing by 100 moves the decimal two places to the left.
We want to get away from being a percent so let's move the decimal two places away from the percent sign.

## Now let's work backwards

Changing decimals percents:
Multiply the decimal by 100.
OR
Move the decimal two places to the right.
Changing decimals to fractions:
Write it how you say it.
Changing fractions to percents:
Change fraction to decimal by dividing, then change decimal to percent by multiplying by 100 OR moving the decimal two places to the right.
